



	DBO Equipment Rules for iQFoil and IFCA 2023 (DBO-ER)
<b>1</b>	<b>RULES</b>
<b>1.1</b>	<p><a href="#">The iQFoil Class Rules 2022</a> (iQCR) and  <a href="#">The iQFoil Youth and Junior Class Rules 2022</a> (iQYJ) are modified as described by  <a href="#">The iQFoil Open 2020 Equipment Rules</a> (iQO 2020)</p> <p>with the following changes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a) For the Youth U19 division, max. allowed sail area is 8 m<sup>2</sup></li> <li>b) For the Junior U17 division, <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• max. allowed sail area is 7 m<sup>2</sup>,</li> <li>• max. allowed front wing area is 800 cm<sup>2</sup> and</li> <li>• the foil mast shall be made of aluminium.</li> </ul> </li> <li>c) In the Women, Junior, and Youth divisions an additional, smaller sail can be used (if considered necessary e.g., by inexperienced participants)</li> </ul>
<b>1.2</b>	Participants with equipment that does not comply with 1.1 can participate in a separate division.
<b>1.3</b>	Foil, board and sail shall be registered no later than 3 days before the first day of racing at: <a href="https://docs.google.com/forms/d/1LX3XdiB6jtRhZOm8Tnzvoy-MP4KCFL9AZBNTQFGY_vU">https://docs.google.com/forms/d/1LX3XdiB6jtRhZOm8Tnzvoy-MP4KCFL9AZBNTQFGY_vU</a>
<b>1.4</b>	In <a href="#">IFCA class rule</a> A.9.1 and B.1.2 World Sailing registered iQFoil, Formula and Wave boards are added and can therefore be used for IFCA Slalom.
<b>1.5</b>	In IFCA class rule C.6.2 will apply and both fin and foil equipment can therefore be used for IFCA Slalom if water depth and conditions allow.
<b>1.6</b>	In IFCA class rule D.1.2, board max. width is changed from 911 mm to 1005 mm.
<b>1.7</b>	Sail numbers for iQFoil and IFCA Slalom must comply with either iQFoil class rule H.2 or RRS appendix G1.2.

<b>2</b>	<b>CLOTHING AND EQUIPMENT</b>
<b>2.1</b>	iQFoil class rule C.3.2.a (i) is changed to allow any suitable helmet, independent of colour and certification standard.
<b>2.2</b>	iQFoil class rule C.1.1 (a) is changed according to Danish law and a personal flotation and impact vest is therefore always required on the water.
<b>2.3</b>	Vest and helmet as described in 2.1 and 2.2 are required for both iQFoil and IFCA Slalom.
