



Stage 5 of the DIF/DS/DBO Danish Championships 2023 for iQFoil and IFCA Slalom Ebeltoft Windsurfklub, October 7-8th 2023	
1	RULES
1.1	The event is governed by the rules as defined in <i>The Racing Rules of Sailing</i> including the prescriptions of Nordic Sailing Federation and Danish Sailing Association.
1.2	Furthermore, the following applies: RRS Appendix B, except RRS B5 61.1 and B8.A8 (for iQFoil), Windsurfing Slalom Racing Rules (WSRR) (for IFCA Slalom), RRS Appendix T , (IFCA) Championship Rules (for IFCA Slalom), Statutes for the Danish Championships in Sailing , DBO Equipment Rules for iQFoil and IFCA (DBO-ER) 2023 and DBO Championship Rules for iQFoil and IFCA (DBO-CR) 2023 .
1.3	In IFCA Championship Rule 9.1, the minimum wind speed is changed from 11 knots to 14 knots.
2	SAILING INSTRUCTIONS
2.1	The sailing instructions will be available the day before the event at dbo.dk .
3	COMMUNICATION
3.1	The online official notice board is located at dbo.dk and in the Danish Championships WhatsApp Group . Only messages from the Principal Race Officer shall be considered official notices.
4	ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY
4.1	The event is open to all types of windsurf boards as described in the DBO Equipment Rules.
4.2	Participants that are not a member of the Danish Boardsailing Organisation or

	similar NCA can participate in the “Open” class as described by the DBO Championship Rules.												
4.3	Participants must enter the event by registering online at dbo.klub-modul.dk .												
4.4	To be considered an entry in the event, a participant shall complete all registration requirements and pay all fees.												
4.5	At the discretion of the organiser, late entries may be accepted but only on dbo.klub-modul.dk . Late-entered participants will be seeded last in the heat eliminations and will not count towards the number of prizes and titles.

8	DATA PROTECTION												
8.1	<p>The organizing authority uses necessary data about competitors for event administrative purposes. Data will be published to the extent it is needed for the purposes of publication of results etc., as well as communication about results and, more generally, about the event, as could be required / expected at a regatta. During the event, photos and videos may be recorded for publication. This could be, but is not restricted to, publication at web, social media, press releases and</p>

9	RISK STATEMENT
9.1	RRS 3 states: ‘The responsibility for a boat’s decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.’ By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.
10	PRIZES
10.1	At the discretion of the organizer, trophies may be awarded for the event to the first one to three competitors in each valid division, depending on number of entries 10 days before the event. Depending on number of entries, prizes are expected in the following divisions: U17, U19, Men and Women.
